



24 Tournament

Description: 24 is a game that tests your ability to do mental math. It is played as a competition between two people, who compete to reach the answer as fast possible. Each contestant is given four numbers, and must place operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division) between them such that the result is 24.

Rules:

1. The competition will be run in winner stays format. Competitors face off one-on-one and the winner of each individual stays and a new challenger goes up.
2. Competitors are split up into two groups, by grade, each with their own tournament – Grades 3 to 5, and grades 6 to 8.
3. The individual face-offs are only one round. The loser of the round has to go back in line, and the winner gets to stay and continually play until he/she loses.
4. Problems are presented by the judge one-by-one. The next card will be presented only after the previous card is solved.
5. If a contestant has an answer to a card, they must raise their hand, and give their answer only after the judge has acknowledged them.
6. If they give an incorrect answer, their opponent wins the card by default.
7. Prizes will be awarded every 12 minutes. When 12 minutes are up, the winner of the last round receives a prize.

Prizes:
